Weddings at Penicuik Estate unfold among ancient trees, starlit gardens and time spent with those you cherish most. Every detail feels woven into the landscape, creating celebrations that are deeply personal and shaped by the beauty of the estate.

Just ten miles south of Edinburgh, Penicuik Estate spans 3,100 hectares of designed landscape framed by the Pentland Hills. At its heart, Penicuik House becomes the centrepiece of every wedding. With its welcoming bedrooms, light-filled drawing rooms, the Courtyard and Rose Garden, it brings everyone together and provides beautiful settings for ceremonies, receptions and relaxed gatherings.

Nestled beside the house in the Sunken Garden, The Orangery is a modern haven of glass, greenery and light. By day it offers a bright setting for ceremonies throughout the year, while by night it glows softly with music and candlelight.

Beyond the house, the estate opens into extraordinary outdoor settings, from sailcloth tents beside the High Pond to the historic setting of Old Penicuik House and the tranquil walled garden at Eskfield. Each celebration, whether intimate or grand, is shaped with care and thoughtful attention to detail.

Penicuik House

Steeped in history and carefully restored, Penicuik House blends heritage with modern comfort. Art collected by the family over centuries mixes with salvaged pieces from Old Penicuik House and contemporary touches, creating an atmosphere that is as timeless as it is welcoming.

The light-filled sitting room and elegant drawing room provide beautiful settings for ceremonies and relaxed moments together. The formal dining room seats up to 48 for the wedding breakfast, allowing the day's celebrations to unfold effortlessly within the house.

As dusk settles, open fires flicker and the wood-panelled bar and adjoining snug become vibrant social hubs for cocktails, conversation and celebration. The dining room sets the scene for dinners that stretch late into the night, while the cinema room offers a quieter pace for those who wish to unwind.



Penicuik House Bedrooms

With eleven suites and five generous double bedrooms, all en-suite, Penicuik House sleeps 32 guests overnight. Additional guest accommodation is available nearby in our beautiful collection of lovingly restored cottages and houses, allowing close family and friends to remain part of the celebration throughout the weekend.

Beyond the house, gardens and pathways invite gentle exploration. From the Italian Courtyard and Rose Garden to winding paths leading towards the High Pond, the landscape offers space to wander, pause and reconnect between moments of celebration.

Entirely yours for the duration of your wedding, Penicuik House offers the rare luxury of time, space and togetherness, a place to gather, celebrate and slow down.







The Orangery

The Orangery is a modern haven of glass, greenery, and light. By day, it feels bright and open, filled with reflections of sky and meadow, offering a light-filled sanctuary for ceremonies year-round. By night, it glows softly against the trees, alive with music and candlelight.

Ideal for larger weddings, The Orangery seats up to 150 guests for dinner and dancing or accommodates 200 for dinner alone, flowing seamlessly between the house, garden, and evening under the stars.





High Pond Reserve

Just a few minutes' walk from Penicuik House, the High Pond feels worlds away, a tranquil stretch of water framed by ancient woodland and the gentle rise of the Pentland Hills.

During the warmer months, the waterside gardens are perfect for open-air ceremonies and drinks receptions. As dusk settles, sailcloth tents take on a gentle glow, their canopies softly lit against the evening sky.

Entirely exclusive and wonderfully adaptable, the High Pond offers a blank canvas for beautifully romantic celebrations of up to 250 guests, where the atmosphere is defined by light on water, firelight after dark, and a deep connection to nature.



Celebration Spaces

Steeped in history, the atmospheric ruins of Old Penicuik House provide a dramatic and unforgettable backdrop. The roofless stone shell, with its grand archways and open-air grandeur, is a breathtaking space for unique wedding ceremonies or theatrical dinners.

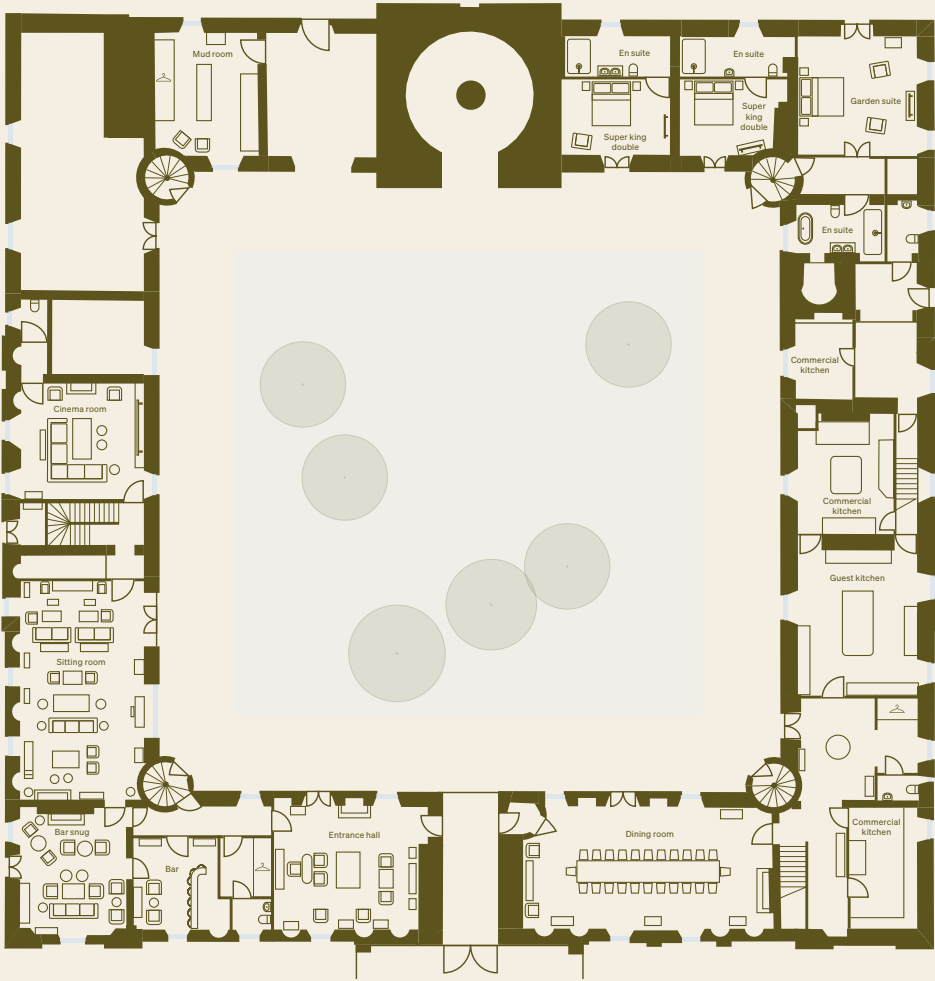

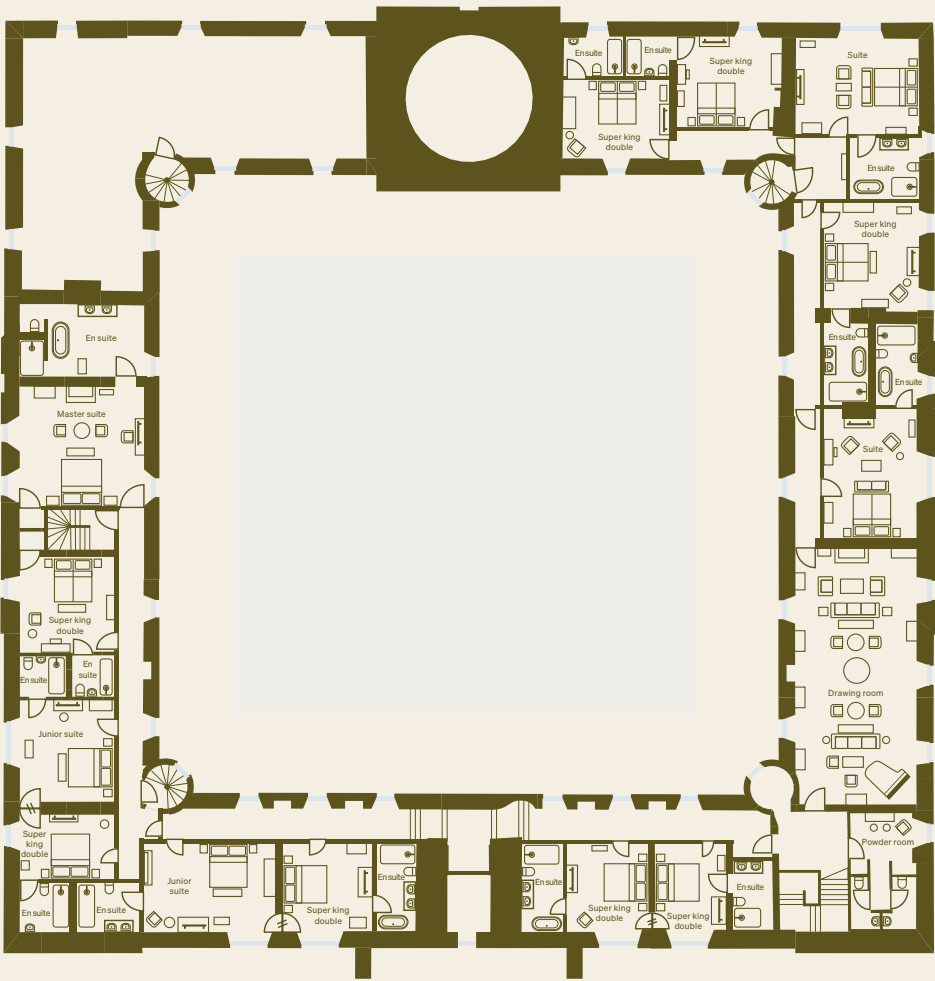

Your wedding weekend might begin with a feast around the fire, the scent of cedar-plank salmon in the air, sizzling shellfish platters and ribeye steaks over the flames. For the big day, think long, airy lunches or dinners served by candlelight, with tables laid for sharing dishes that feel refined yet relaxed.

As the evening unfolds, the kitchen returns with midnight feasts of wood-fired pizzas and burgers, keeping the celebration flowing late into the night. By Sunday, brunches linger into the afternoon, softening the pace and bringing everyone back together once more.

Each menu is thoughtfully created around your celebration, using exceptional ingredients sourced from the estate and trusted Scottish suppliers. 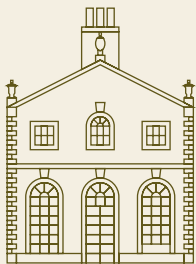

Eskfield

Sleeps 2



Built in 1714, Eskfield is our Palladian spa house, one of the most important features of the Penicuik Designed Landscape. It sits within an astonishing 1.5-hectare Arcadian walled garden, surrounded by ancient woodland in every direction.

With a burn running through orchard and wildflower meadow, Eskfield offers a natural sanctuary where the only sounds are birdsong and the soft whisper of water. This early 18th-century villa has been reimagined for pure relaxation.

An orangery-styled sitting room is bathed in morning light, flowing seamlessly into a serene kitchen warmed by a double-sided wood-burner. Upstairs, the entire first floor is devoted to a sweeping bedroom suite, complete with a roll-top bath and rain shower beneath high ceilings.

The private spa includes a sauna, cold plunge and cedar hot tub, with outdoor dining and seating set within the walled garden.



Clermount

Sleeps 2



Built in 1874 and nestled within Penicuik Estate's designed landscape, Clermount is an idyllic retreat, where nature meets luxury, with far-reaching views of pasture and ancient woodland.

Secluded among old trees and open views, Clermount is both hideaway and home. The kitchen is ready for simple suppers, while the cosy living room offers evenings by the wood-burner and a deep window seat designed for lingering.

Upstairs, a private retreat awaits, a spacious super-king bedroom with sweeping views, a roll-top bath for soaking, and a generous shower for refreshing starts to the day.

Outside, a sun-dappled terrace features a Big Green Egg barbecue, outdoor wood-burner and cedar hot tub overlooking the surrounding landscape.



Stable Park

Sleeps 8



Surrounded by ancient woodland, Stable Park is a four-bedroom house with spectacular views across the designed landscape. Built in 1873 for the Estate's Head Gardener, this Grade A listed house has been lovingly restored and completely remodelled.

Designed for relaxed gatherings, the open-plan kitchen and dining space looks out across rolling lawns and woodland, while the sitting room draws everyone together around the warmth of the wood-burner beside an elegant bay window.

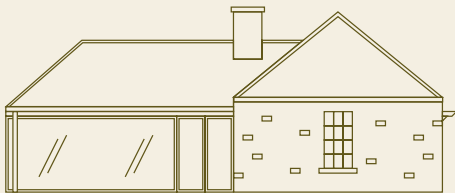
Upstairs, four airy bedrooms, two en-suite and two sharing a generous family bathroom, feature super-king beds, garden vistas and space to unwind.

Outside, doors open onto a long terrace, with a Big Green Egg barbecue, cedar hot tub and outdoor wood-burner set among the trees.



Eastlin

Sleeps 2



Built in the 1700s as the Porter’s Lodge for Penicuik House, Eastlin is an eclectic bolthole, uniquely designed with charming, fun and worldly interiors.

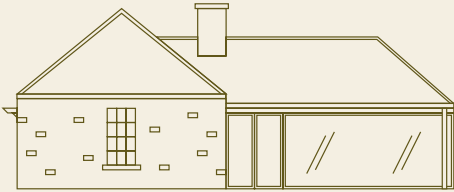
Nestled beneath towering trees, Eastlin draws on its lodge-porter heritage to create a retreat of gentle quiet. Inside, the wood-burner casts a warm glow over tranquil spaces, while the kitchen supports slow mornings and uncomplicated suppers.

The super-king bedroom features a deep soaking bath and rainfall shower, designed for unhurried days. Outside, the terrace sits beneath the woodland canopy, with a Big Green Egg barbecue, cedar hot tub and outdoor wood-burner.



Westlin

Sleeps 2



Originally built in the 1700s as the Porter’s Lodge for Penicuik House, Westlin is a perfectly proportioned hideaway with playful, light-hearted interiors.

Wrapped in woodland and shifting sunlight, the sitting room offers a calm, welcoming space, while the kitchen is ready for everything from simple breakfasts to relaxed suppers.

The bright super-king bedroom includes a soaking bath and rain shower. Outside, the terrace features a Big Green Egg barbecue, outdoor wood-burner and cedar hot tub, creating a peaceful setting beneath the trees.

Located close to Eastlin, Westlin works well alongside it, offering neighbouring cottages with independent space.

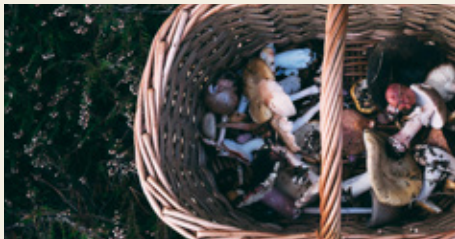


The Penicuik Designed Landscape and Palladian architecture are considered to be among the finest in Scotland.

Helicopter guests are always welcome by private arrangement.

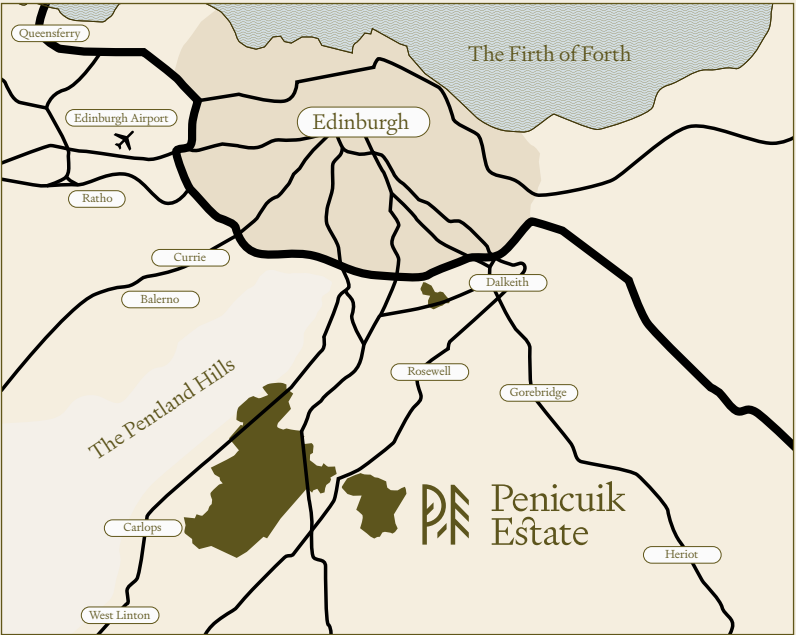
Our helipad is within 150m of Penicuik House.

To help with planning, the following examples give an indication of how weddings at Penicuik Estate are typically structured.

Low Season 2 Night Weekend Wedding

Exclusive use of Penicuik House (including full breakfast for 32 guests), all estate cottages (sleeping an additional 16 guests) and use of the The Orangery for celebrations for up to 150 guests, from £38,000 inc VAT.

High Season 2 Night Weekend Wedding

Exclusive use of Penicuik House (including full breakfast for 32 guests), all estate cottages (sleeping an additional 16 guests) and use of The Orangery for celebrations for up to 150 guests, from £48,400 inc VAT.

The above pricing reflects 2026 rates. Final costs may vary depending on the season, guest numbers and the overall style and structure of your celebration.

All food and beverages are provided by our in-house Estate Kitchen, in partnership with The Edinburgh Catering Company, with menus shaped around you and your guests, and guided by the season. As a guide, a three-course menu with canapés starts from £95 per person inc VAT.
